PROTECT OUR WATERWAYS

STOP THE SPREAD OF FRESHWATER PESTS

CHECK

Remove all plant material from items that have been in the water.

CLEAN

Soak or scrub all items for at least one minute in a 5% solution of detergent.

DRY

If cleaning is not practical, dry items completely and then leave for at least 48 hours.

See www.biosecurity.govt.nz/cleaning for more ways to Check, Clean, Dry. If you restrict your activity to a single waterway there is no need to Check, Clean, Dry.
